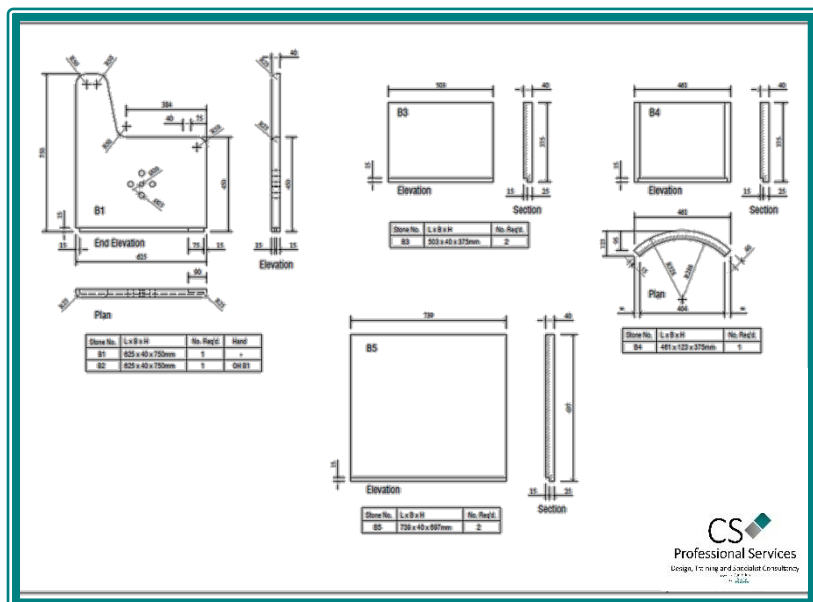

Stone Design Service

We offer an optional design service for the natural stone element of projects **where Cumbrian Stone is contracted for the stone supply**. This service is charged at an additional fee over and above the stone supply cost.

If required, our team will work with you and your design team to produce full CAD component and layout drawings for the natural stone element of the design, enabling the accurate quotation, manufacture and construction of your project.

These component drawings and schedules are usually produced by working from the architect's elevation and floorplan drawings, ensuring that each component fits with your finished building. We can also work closely with your chosen structural engineer/steel fabricators, window manufacturers and site team to ensure that these components tie together perfectly once they arrive on site.

Design Terms

Any design produced by Cumbrian Stone is provided in order to enable the correct production and construction of your stone components only, and are based on the information provided to us by your design team. Our designs make no allowance for any requirements or conditions that may be imposed by Building Regulations, structural requirements or any other elements of the project design unless expressly confirmed as part of the design supplied. Cumbrian Stone would always recommend that any design provided is double checked for accuracy and suitability by you / your designer / architect / structural engineer / stone installer before being authorised for production. Cumbrian Stone accepts no liability for any costs arising as a result of designs not being checked thoroughly at the point of order.

Costs and Design Lead Time

The cost of producing CAD designs for your project will depend on the level of complexity and size of your project. If a design is required on your project, we can offer a quotation for this work alongside the initial budget costings for your stone supply.

The lead time for your design will also depend on the size and complexity of your project, and will also be influenced by how many other projects we have in our design queue at the time of your order. We always recommend securing your design as early as possible once your construction issue drawings have been finalised in order to help minimise the risk of any delays, as often we are unable to commence your production lead time until the design has been completed and signed off by your team.

In order to help keep both design costs and lead times to a minimum we always ask that wherever possible the information/drawings that we design from are the final issue drawings, as once our component design work is underway any changes to the overall layout/construction of your project can result in large portions of the stonework needing redesigned/alterd to suit these changes. This can often result in additional costs over and above the original design quote, and can also impact the expected stone supply date.
